





The center is hosted by the University of Wuppertal which has already proven itself in many other projects and ventures. With the interdisciplinary centres for "Machine Learning and Data Analytics" and "Mobility & Energy", the university is well positioned for future challenges. Furthermore CAMO.NRW works closely with other projects such as "Bergisch.Smart: Artificial Intelligence as an Enabler of Tomorrow's Mobility" and the cluster initiative automotiveland.nrw e.V.. The University of Wuppertal is also involved in the Initiative of Automated and Connected Driving of the German Association of the Automotive Industry (VDA).

By tapping into the knowledge and resources of these projects CAMO.NRW prepares municipalities and businesses by providing information about automated driving and future mobility. By supporting these various stakeholders, CAMO.NRW tries to shape the transformation in a positive way and thereby overcome existing barriers.


CAMO.NRW developed with the "camo compass" a tool that analyses the status quo in terms of the implementation of automated mobility in cities and rural areas. In addition to that, the center works on field tests including a driving simulator: With the VR-Demonstrator CAMO.NRW tries to point out, what the vehicle sees, what kind of information is recorded and which difficulties can occur by using and processing data.
