

#### **Cheongna Lake Park**





#### + Transportation Card



T-money Service Center within the subway station (for KRW 50,000 or less)





#### + One-time Subway Card

This is a one-time use card bought at any vending machine installed in a subway station and used only on the day of purchase. An additional KRW 500 is needed as a card deposit. When arriving at the destination subway station, place the card in the card collector and the card deposit will be returned.
