

Seoul's scale-up policy

To accelerate the growth of startups, the Seoul Metropolitan Government (SMG) formed the \$1billion "Seoul Future Growth Fund" in 2018 and it passed \$2billion as of Feb. 2021.

The fund is mainly being invested in the industries of biotech, culture & contents, smart city and industry 4.0 as well as startups and comeback startups.


